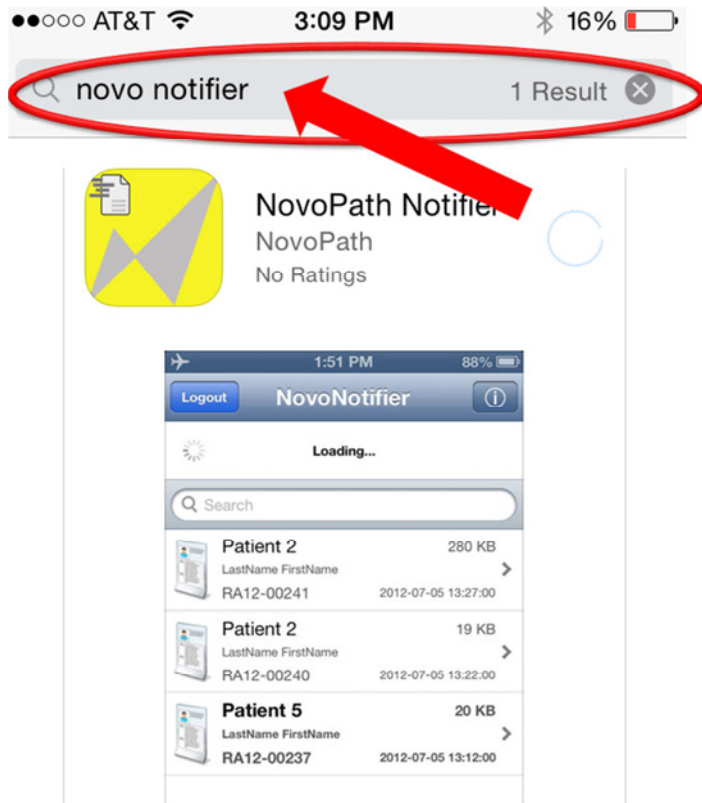




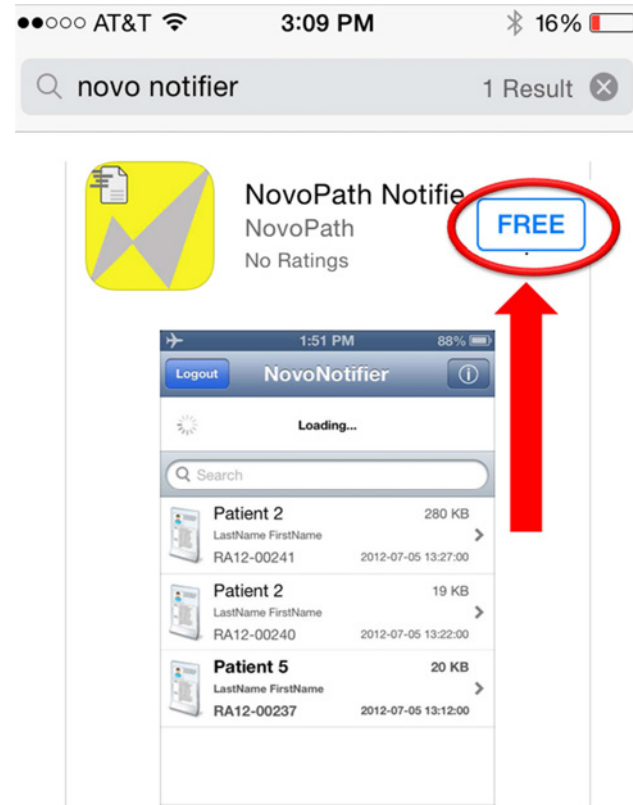

Installation Guide

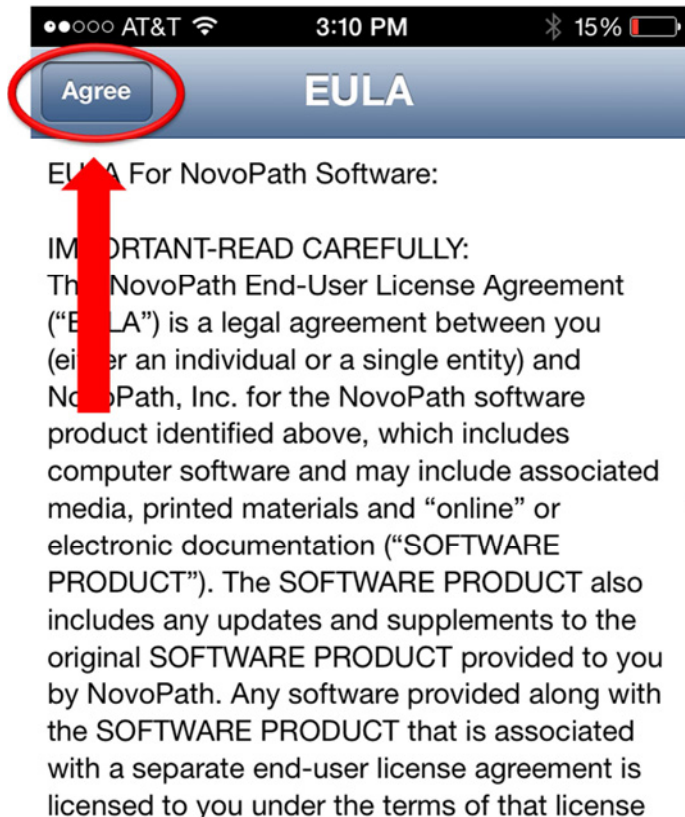
1. Search for the NovoNotifier app on your app store.



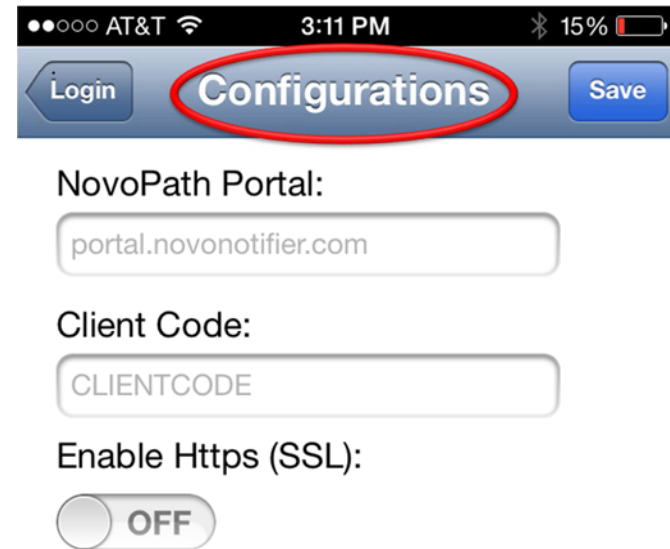
2. Install the NovoNotifier app.



3. Click the “Agree” button for the EULA




4. You will then be directed to the “Configurations” page.



5. Enter the following website address under the NovoPath Portal field:



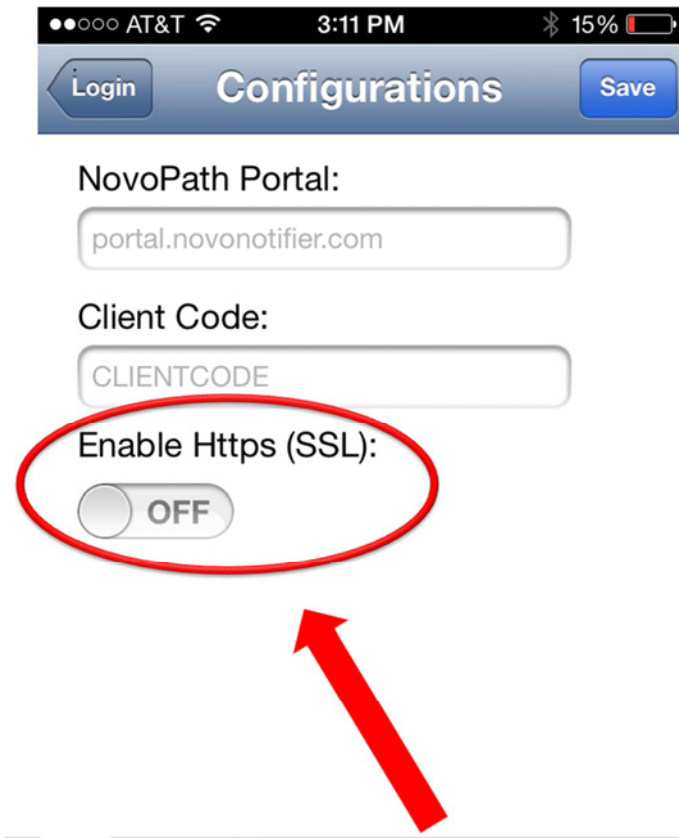
6. Enter your Client Code under the client code field.

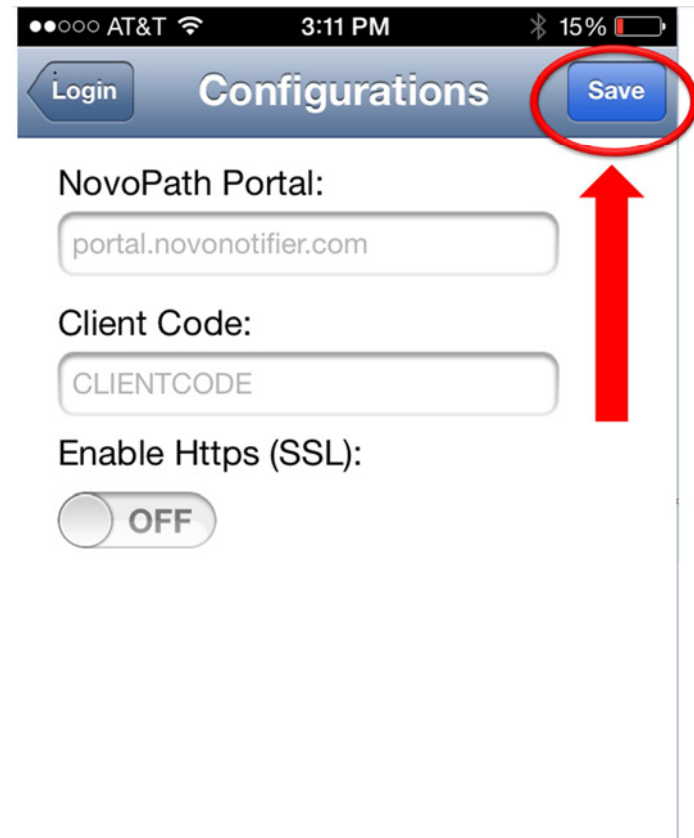

7. Switch the “Enable Https (SSL):” button to ON




8. Click SAVE
