TOPA Update, October 2015 Molecular Diagnostics: Results Summary

The attached tables record the results of GI and Respiratory panels performed at TOPA Diagnostics. This data may aid in identifying seasonal variation and understanding the prevalence of these pathogens in the community (including Ventura and Los Angeles counties).

GI Panel:

C. difficile and Enteropathogenic E. coli continue to be the most common bacterial pathogens identified. Norovirus has been the most common viral pathogen identified in the past 2 months.

Respiratory Panel:
